**Ages:** The center cares for children from 6 weeks through 5 years.

**Hours of Operation:** 6:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

### Center Staff:

Individuals employed are chosen not only for their educational achievements and training but also for their previous experience in the early childhood field. Hildebrandt Learning Centers follows the employment guidelines of the PA Department of Public Welfare including state police and child abuse clearances.



### Staff To Child Ratios:

Infant	1 staff to 4 children
Young Toddler	1 staff to 5 children
Older Toddler	1 staff to 6 children
Preschool	1 staff to 10 children

**Nutrition:** Breakfast and afternoon snack are provided by the center for all children except those not able to partake of table food. Lunch is provided by Dining Services at Landis Homes. Menus are developed and monitored by a registered dietitian.

**Playground:** Abundant outdoor space is available for gross motor activities and includes age-appropriate playground equipment. In addition, an impact-absorbing safety surface covers the playground area. This surface meets the requirements of the Consumer Protection Agency.

**Building Safety:** Our center features a key pad security system which allows only parents and staff access to the building.

**Child Care Subsidy/Pre-Tax Care Account:** Landis Homes employees and families of the community who use the center are eligible for a child care subsidy.

### Curriculum

Our center's curriculum is designed to meet the whole needs of the child (physical, social, emotional, cognitive, self-help skills) in accordance with Best Practice guidelines established by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). Our center also utilizes PA educational standards and outcomes of young children as the foundation for teacher planned and directed in-depth studies and projects.



Age appropriate "learning centers" and learning materials enable children to become personally engaged in their own active learning. Responsive teacher-child interactions and partnerships with families create a quality environment for development and learning, allowing children to begin life with a positive approach to learning.
